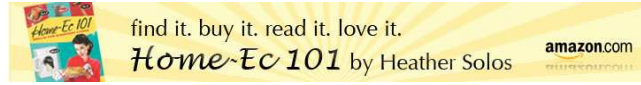

I will share approaches I use to match your family preferences to good campgrounds and make the process a fun family experience.

Plan your Camping Trip

Make an easy to update list or chart. Use sample headings like the following to write notes underneath:

- Type of camping trip
- When – season, actual dates
- Activities available
- Amenities available
- Region/location
- Campground name
- Equipment
- Reservations – Deposits

Ask five key questions to determine specific campground search details.

1. Will you stay multiple days in one location and with family activities to explore like outdoor education, guided hikes, science classes, or go to nearby indoor activities, amusement parks, or community events to schedule in your itinerary?
2. Are you driving across country with limited time and want to stay one night at one location to sleep and eat instead of using motels? Searches include safe family public camping areas with amenities to use for meal preparation, shower facilities, and a recreation room for younger children.
3. Will you stay several days in another city/region to visit friends and family and need to camp overnight so not to be a burden and keep
